Please find an [Action Memo](#) recommending the utilization of an existing agreement with the WHO to utilize previously obligated funds to access a critical stockpile of PPE and lab supplies to support the Uganda Ebola outbreak response.

We seek your clearance, and further distribution for clearance through the USAID FO and transmittal to State/F.

While the activities would normally be covered in the regular process for the lifesaving humanitarian assistance waiver, this memo is drafted for approval from State/F Director, given that the implementing partner of the agreement is WHO, the subject of a separate Executive Order.

This action is urgent to provide the critical supplies to support the Ebola outbreak response, and our team stands ready to answer any questions you may have, or to meet to discuss the memo if helpful.
