Thanks for the clarifications by phone. Confirming that we will move forward with this proposed approach, and will provide regular updates to the FO on the activities that I approve to resume/continue under the lifesaving humanitarian assistance waiver, so that you will have a full accounting of activities and budgets. Similarly for the specific PEPFAR waiver, we will continue to update via spreadsheet the activities that were determined to move forward under the criteria defined in that memo.

Further confirming that no activities listed in the exceptions will be allowed to resume, and that decisions will be made judiciously in accordance with the guidance, and only those intended to avert loss of life within the next 90 days, unless/until we receive further guidance.
